#### Health and educational fairs



- As Chile Positivo, we participate in different health and educational fairs throughout the country. In these fairs, we provide people and particularly, young people, with information on sexuality, Sexual Rights, HIV and other STI prevention strategies.
- During these fairs we engage with people through different fun games such as: answering questions, how to properly put a condom on a dildo (and how to do it with your mouth), as well as other fun activities. We also share fun and educational documents like the genderbread figure to teach about sexuality and we also give away exterior and interior condoms and lube, at no cost.

### HIV testing sites



- As Chile Positivo, we actively promote and organize HIV testing sites throughout Chile. We have travelled throughout the different regions of our country to bring HIV testing closer to communities and to young people (through HIV rapid tests).
- Which is why we have worked along universities, high schools and local governments to bring HIV testing to young people aged 14 and above.

### **Educational workshops**



- As Chile Positivo, we use different educational tools to teach about HIV, HIV prevention and sexuality. These are especially important to use among young people, such as Kahoot and Menti. Kahoot allows participants to engage more in the subject because it's presented as a game were they can participate anonymously and earn prizes at the end.
- In our educational workshop we emphasize the **importance of including pleasure** as a relevant dimension of HIV prevention.
